

Covid Guidelines for Cambridge Hebrew School Autumn Term 2020

Cambridge Hebrew School will be running hybrid classes for the Autumn Term. This means that classes will be held at the Chabad House, whilst streaming over zoom for those who need to isolate. If a member of staff needs to isolate, parents will be informed that classes will be held on the zoom platform for those weeks.

As the Hebrew School will be children from various bubbles coming together we will be taking extra precautions at the start of the school year. Measures we will take to keep children and staff safe whilst at the Chabad House for classes:

1. Parents will need to fill in a quick covid safe screening each week confirming their child's health and covid exposure status.
2. A register will be taken for track and trace purposes.
3. Everyone must use hand sanitiser upon entry.
4. Coats must be hung on the hooks rather than on backs of chairs.
5. Children will be seated slightly apart, their space boundaries clearly marked.
6. Each child will have their own stationary and supplies tray.
7. Children will be asked to use hand sanitiser before using the bathroom.
8. Disposable hand towels will be available rather than cloth ones.
9. Snacks will be individually wrapped biscuits and juice which will be eaten outside whenever possible.
10. Children will not be permitted to sit on lounge furniture.
11. Rooms will be well ventilated.
12. Masks are not compulsory according to the Sunday School guidance, however children may wear masks as an extra layer of protection.
13. Parents should not access the building for pick up, rather ring the buzzer and we will send your child out to you.
14. A cleaning process will take place before and after classes.
15. Should a member of staff need to self-isolate, their class will move to zoom for those weeks.
16. Should a child need to self-isolate, they can access their class via zoom for those weeks.
